



Moser Baer Trust has achieved another milestone in reaffirming our strong commitment as a responsible corporate by setting up a solar powered computer centre in village Surajpur, Greater Noida.

We have undertaken this initiative to reinforce our commitment towards the society and environment. Being a responsible organization in the business of renewable/green energy, this move is perhaps one of first of its kind in this region. We would like to share with you that there is no day time electricity supply to this village and therefore, earlier we were bound to run this centre on diesel generator. MBT's efforts to replace diesel with clean energy got a breakthrough when MBPVL agreed to support and convert this centre into solar powered centre. We are thankful to our colleagues from MBPV, Corporate communications and Admin, GN Plant for all their support and cooperation.

On 22nd September 2010, Ms. Nita Puri, Director HR & Admin, MBIL and Trustee of Moser Baer Trust, inaugurated this solar powered digital literacy centre in Shaheed Bhagat Singh, Surajpur, Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh. The inauguration of the centre was followed by the certification of 70 passed out students from three digital literacy centres.



Considering the huge demand for computer skills in this region and also to ensure decent livelihood options for the local and migrant communities, Moser Baer Trust is currently running 4 Knowledge Centres in NOIDA, Greater Noida and Ghaziabad in partnership with Nasscom Foundation. It is also to be noted that the computers used in these centres are refurbished old computers donated by responsible corporate citizens. Through these centres we are imparting computer literacy courses which are jointly certified by Microsoft under their Unlimited Potential Program and Moser Baer Trust. Since 2008, we have trained over 750 students from the surrounding villages. Currently these 4 centres are imparting training to 318 students.
